Provide **one** of the following forms of identification showing current address:

- A current Driver's Licence.
- A current lease agreement.
- A current rates notice.
- A current Centrelink pension/health card.

**OR** provide **two** of the following forms of identification showing your name and current address:

- A current electricity bill;
- A current telephone bill;
- A current water bill;
- A current gas bill;
- A current bank statement/Medicare statement of benefit;
- A current rent receipt.

# A How-To Guide

## Permanent Members

### For Local Residents

To become a permanent member you will need to take the following steps:

1. Provide identification containing proof of address (see overleaf for identification requirements).

## Temporary Members

### For visitors from within Western Australia

To become a temporary member you will need to take the following steps:

1. Provide identification containing proof of address (see overleaf for identification requirements).
2. Must provide email address **or** local postal address for holds.

## Lite Members

### For visitors who live interstate/ internationally or who have no proof of address

To become a lite member you will need to take the following steps:

1. A form of identification is required.
2. No address is required but is preferred.

## South West Library Consortia (SWLC)



### Terms and Conditions for Users of SWLC

1. Users must present a membership card at all times to access services.
2. The Cardholder/Guardian is responsible for any items borrowed on their membership card.
3. Guardians must be present with identification when registering users under the age of 18.
4. A lending period of 21 days applies.
5. One renewal per item is permitted unless otherwise advised by the lending library.
6. Items must be returned or renewed by the due date advised at the time of lending.
7. Your membership type determines your borrowing privileges; Full, Temp or Lite Users.
8. A maximum of 30 items per full membership at any one time.
9. A maximum of 20 holds per full membership from within the consortia.
10. A maximum of 4 inter-library loans per full membership at any one time.
11. Users must abide by the local policies of the lending library.
12. Some services may differ between libraries within the consortia.
13. The user's home library service may offer access to different services.
14. Users may borrow or return items to any library within the consortia.
15. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions may cause suspension of services.
16. South West Library Consortia reserves the right to change the terms and conditions in accordance with the Operations Guidelines.
