Who?

Library Cards

- You must present your card each time you borrow.
- Lost or damaged cards can be replaced for a cost of **\$5.00**.

Permanent Members

- **30 items** per permanent member may be borrowed (limit of 10 DVDs).
- Maximum of 20 holds from within Consortia Libraries.
- Maximum of 4 inter-library loan holds at any one time.

Lite Members

- **2 items** per lite member may be borrowed.
- Holds unavailable.



How?

Items may be borrowed for three weeks.

Items may be renewed once if there are no holds on the item.

Holds and Renewals:

May be made in the following ways:

- a) in person at the library
- b) by phone
- c) using our online catalogue
- d) by email

When a hold arrives you will be notified by mail, email or SMS

Holds will not be taken for Lite members.

All members may borrow or return at any of the libraries belonging to the 'One Library' consortia.

An account will be sent for items that are 6 weeks overdue. Once an account is raised, no borrowings are allowed on the membership until the item is returned or the account is paid.
