

Computer and Internet Use Rules

To use the computers at the City of Busselton Libraries, please read and agree to these rules:

1. Bookings and Time Limits

You can book a computer for one hour at a time.

The maximum total time allowed is two hours per day.

2. Rules for Children and Teens

Parents are responsible for what their children (under 18) do online.

During school hours (9:00 am – 3:00 pm): Children under 16 cannot use the computers unless they are with a parent/guardian or have an official school pass.

3. Online Behaviour and Content

Be respectful: No cyberbullying, vandalism, or installing your own software.

Follow the law: Do not access illegal or pornographic material. You must also respect copyright and censorship laws.

Prohibited Content: You must not view or show content that includes extreme violence, cruelty, or serious criminal activity. Content that could upset children or offend other library users is not allowed. Accessing illegal or highly disturbing violent material may be reported to the police. Printing this type of content is also not permitted.

Consequences: If you break these rules, we will end your session immediately. You may also be permanently banned from using library computers.

4. Safety and Responsibility

Technical Risks: We aren't responsible for website errors, trouble saving files, or the accuracy of information you find online.

Right to Stop: The library reserves the right to block certain sites or end any session at any time for any reason.
